OTHER ACTIVITIES: There are hiking trails on the Fairhaven property, as well as a mountain stream with a pleasant waterfall to enjoy. Nearby Roan Mountain State Park has plenty of outdoor activities for persons who want to get out and about during the days of the conference; check out the Roan Mountain State Park website for more information. COST OF 3 DAY CONFERENCE AND LODGING (Early Bird prices in effect through May 31st)

Staying on site:

\$150 per attendee (age 17 and up), \$125 per *child attendee (age 16 and under)

This includes lodging (a bedding space in chalet), a 3-day conference ticket, and *meal participation.

*Note: There will be no charge for small children and infants who use sleeping bags instead of bed/sofa space, please limit 1 unpaid infant/child per adult attendee.

Staying off site:

\$90 per attendee (age 17 and up), \$65 per *child attendee (age 11 through 16)

3-day conference ticket, and meal participation.

*Note: There will be no charge for children 10 and under, please limit 1 unpaid child per adult attendee.

***TENTATIVE MEAL PARTICIPATION:**

Friday: Dinner = Full meal provided.

Saturday: Breakfast = doughnuts, muffins, milk, juice, coffee.

Snacks and beverages during conference.

Note: Lunches will not be provided; we will break for lunch so that everyone will have time to enjoy lunch at their chalet or at the nearby Whiteway Grill.

CHALET INFORMATION: Furnished chalets and cottages are designed to accommodate up to six people. In addition to a gracious living area with a sleeper sofa, there is a bedroom with a queen-size bed, and a loft with two twin beds. A full bath includes a tub with shower. The kitchen is equipped with coffee maker, microwave, dishes, utensils, pots and pans, a full-size refrigerator, and a full-size range.

LODGING ACCOMODATIONS: We have 14 each queen size beds, 28 each twin beds, and 14 each double sleeper sofas. Due to limited on-site accommodations, we may need to fill chalets to maximum occupancy; we plan to group couples, friends, and families together as much as possible by request. In some cases, chalets will have to be shared with others outside of your party. Let us know your preferences regarding who you would like to share a chalet with, and your bedding preference (a single twin bed, or share a queen or sofa bed); we will try to accommodate as much as possible.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Pets are strictly not permitted on the Fairhaven Ministries property; there are no exceptions other than guide dogs for the visually impaired. If you need lodging which allows pets, nearby Roan Mountain State Park has 10 pet-friendly cabins on their property located just minutes away. For those with campers and RV's, Roan Mountain State Park also has a full-service campground. There are two privately run RV parks also located nearby.
