

SPEAKER INFORMATION:

Coach Dave Daubenmire - A veteran 35-year high school football coach, was spurred to action when attacked and eventually sued by the ACLU in the late 1990's for mixing prayer with his coaching. As a result, Coach heard the call to move out of coaching a high school team, to the job of coaching God's team. PASS THE SALT was formed to encourage the Body of Christ to step into the cultural war. "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood..." PASS THE SALT is convinced that God has given the Body a window of opportunity to take our culture back. Coach is using his knowledge of education and educational issues to equip Christians to defend the Judeo-Christian worldview. A popular, high-energy speaker, Coach Daubenmire's motivational lectures laced with scripture are challenging Americans across the country to serve on God's team.

John Diamond – Founder and director of Peacemakers Outreach, USAF veteran, author of several books (including "An Appeal To Heaven" and "Fighting The Next American Revolution"), constitutional historian and professor; he holds a Master in Theology and a Doctorate in Christian Education. In January 2013 he created the first American Citizenship School which led to the forming of the American Christian Leadership Alliance (ACLA). John teaches we the people what our roles and responsibilities are in regard to serving God and being citizens of this Constitutional Republic. The information which John provides during his teachings is invaluable for those who support truth and justice.

Scott Lively - Dr. Scott Lively has advocated and modeled the biblical worldview as a writer, speaker, attorney, pastor, human rights consultant, American activist, anti-abortion activist, and missionary for more than 30 years on five continents. He also co-founded Watchmen Of The Walls, was state director of the California branch of the American Family Association, and a spokesman for the [Oregon Citizens Alliance](#). Pastor Scott Lively directs and leads the Revolutionary Remnant Regiment, an official unit of his Swamp Rangers. Pastor Lively's knowledge covers a great expanse in the areas of government, world history, and biblical history; he teaches, preaches and promotes the Gospel, educating anyone with a desire to learn.

Tom Dunn – Christian truther, spiritual warfare intercessor and trainer, filmmaker, and director of the documentary film "Detestable". Tom exposes his audience and students to realities the church often tries to ignore, which includes spiritual attacks, demonic possession, satanic cult rituals, human sacrifice, sexual abuse, human trafficking, etc. Tom teaches you how to recognize and identify these types of evil happenings, provides training on how to protect yourself from becoming a victim and how to take action against the evil that comes upon you in your daily life. As Christians it is essential to be able to recognize evil and know what to do when it comes upon you; Tom teaches these skills.

Brett Bohl – Also known as "Ohio Brett", brother Bohl is an inspirational and motivational speaker, co-author, American activist. Brett's goal is to challenge, encourage and inspire each of his audiences, and pave the way for positive transformational change. He is currently on a tour covering each of the 88 counties of the state of Ohio during which he is promoting truth, justice, and freedom while also providing encouragement, motivation, and inspiration as he goes. Brett regularly promotes and participates in Pass The Salt Ministries events and is a Salt & Light Brigade team player.

Self-defense & Situational Awareness Teaching/Training: Bobby Lee (self-defense instructor and former kickboxing competitor) and Chad Estes (personal defense instructor and retired Texas law enforcement officer) along with other Salt & Light team members plan to run through some situational scenarios during which you will gain knowledge on how to prepare for and protect yourself from attacks by evil doers when they come into your personal space, such as inside your church, a restaurant, your home, etc.

Outing To Roan Mountain: Weather permitting, we also plan to take an outing to Roan Mountain State Park and to Carver's Gap; this will include a hike on the Appalachian Trail along the ridge atop Roan Mountain for those who are interested in making the trek. COST OF 3 DAY CONFERENCE AND LODGING Early-bird 3-day conference prices good through June 31st!

Staying on site:

\$150 per attendee (age 17 and up), \$125 per *child attendee (age 16 and under)

This includes lodging (a bedding space in chalet), a 3-day conference ticket, and *meal participation.

*Note: There will be no charge for small children and infants who use sleeping bags instead of bed/sofa space, please limit 1 unpaid infant/child per adult attendee.

Staying off site:

\$90 per attendee (age 17 and up), \$65 per *child attendee (age 11 through 16)

3-day conference ticket, and meal participation.

*Note: There will be no charge for children 10 and under, please limit 1 unpaid child per adult attendee.

***TENTATIVE MEAL PARTICIPATION:**

Friday: Dinner = Full meal provided.

Saturday: Breakfast = doughnuts, muffins, boiled eggs, milk, juice, coffee.

Snacks and beverages during conference.

CHALET & COTTAGE INFORMATION: Furnished chalets and cottages are designed to accommodate up to six people. In addition to a gracious living area with a sleeper sofa, there is a bedroom with a queen-size bed, and a loft with two twin beds. A full bath includes a tub with shower. The kitchen is equipped with coffee maker, microwave, dishes, utensils, pots and pans, a full-size refrigerator, and a full-size range. The chalets and cottages are located on a property nestled in a mountain hollow. There are hiking trails in these beautiful woods that pass along and over a mountain stream that has a pleasant waterfall to enjoy.

LODGING ACCOMMODATIONS: We have 14 each queen size beds, 28 each twin beds, and 14 each double sleeper sofas. The private bedrooms with queen beds are quickly being filled; reserve yours while they last! Due to limited on-site accommodations, we may need to fill chalets to maximum occupancy; we plan to group couples, friends, and families together as much as possible by request. There will also be men only and women only chalets as needed. In some cases, chalets will have to be shared with others outside of your party. Let us know your preferences regarding who you would like to share a chalet with, and your bedding preference (a single twin bed, or share a queen or sofa bed); we will try to accommodate as much as possible.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Pets are strictly not permitted on the Fairhaven Ministries property; there are no exceptions other than guide dogs for the visually impaired. If you need lodging which allows pets, nearby Roan Mountain State Park has 10 pet-friendly cabins on their property located just minutes away.

OFF-SITE LODGING:

Nearby Roan Mountain State Park has 30 rental cabins on their property.

For those with campers and RV's, Roan Mountain State Park also has a full-service campground. There are two privately run RV parks also located nearby.
