Are you sick of what has been going on in Washington? Are you concerned about the direction our country has been heading? Do you feel isolated, as if you are one of only a handful of people who see what you see and believe as you believe? And are you frustrated because you feel powerless to do anything substantive; anything that will truly make a difference in turning this country around?

**So what are we asking you to do?** Simply this, spread the word in your church and among your friends **to meet at the flag pole at Dalton’s City Hall on each of the next 4 Sunday’s at 3 PM.** Pastors, as our spiritual leaders, please take the lead and make it a church-wide event. If your pastor is unwilling to do so, we the sheep, will have to step up to the plate. We, as American citizens, have the authority – and the obligation – to act. The future of our children and grandchildren are at stake!!!

During the gathering we'll pray, sing a few songs, hear from a couple of speakers and fellowship together. The focus will be on Jesus, and we'll be praying based on 2 Chronicles 7:14:

**"If My people, who are called by My Name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, forgive their sin and heal their land."**

Each succeeding Sunday, every person will be responsible for bringing "a loaf and a fish" to the next meeting. That is, two new persons not from their own church. And each pastor will be asked to bring two new pastors along with their congregations.

After the final meeting on the Sunday before the election, the call will change from "Meet You at the Pole" to **"Meet You at the Polls," where we will cast our ballots.** (This would not necessarily be a collective gathering, just a day to exercise our civic responsibility as we fast and pray for God to meet us at our point of weakness – having done all we can do – to demonstrate His power and mercy.)

Will you, your family, and your congregation participate in this "Meet You at the Polls" rally? Will you share this information with family, friends, other pastors, and Christians you know? **As Paul says in Ephesians 6, it is a spiritual battle we are facing.** Some will undoubtedly suffer in one way or another. But that is exactly what we are called to as the Body of Christ, especially when we step out in faith to further His will.
