

How fast have we become luke-warm? – Ray LeBlanc

Revelation 3:15

I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.

Revelation 3:16

So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

We are entering into perilous times, times that no other generation has ever gone through, yet in their age of "times and troubles" they left us ensamples as God recorded in His holy writ;

2nd Timothy 3:16

"All scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:"

So let's examine a few of these examples given to us! When Jonah ran away from God's Word we can consider that he had become luke-warm in his relationship with God.

Jonah 1:17

Now the LORD had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

Jonah 2:10

And the LORD spake unto the fish, and it vomited out Jonah upon the dry land.

And Jonah began to enter into the city a day's journey, and he cried, and said, Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown.

Jonah 3:5 So the people of Nineveh believed God, and proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them.

6For word came unto the king of Nineveh, and he arose from his throne, and he laid his robe from him, and covered *him* with sackcloth, and sat in ashes.

7And he caused *it* to be proclaimed and published through Nineveh by the decree of the king and his nobles, saying, Let neither man nor beast, herd nor flock, taste any thing: let them not feed, nor drink water:

8But let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily unto God: yea, let them turn every one from his evil way, and from the violence that *is* in their hands.

9Who can tell *if* God will turn and repent, and turn away from his fierce anger, that we perish not?

God created that big fish that spewed a lukewarm man out of its mouth, similar to the scripture we read in Revelation 3:15, expressing His sore displeasure with luke-warmness.

We are entering into day 4 of the 11 days we committed to praying for our nation, its leaders, Israel, the world, praying against spiritual wickedness in ALL places! Let's not forget the fact that these demonic entities know how to fight and they inhabit wicked men, 2nd Corinthians 10:4 "(For the weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)" I think we can also apply this verse to our battle:

Matthew 17:19-2

19Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out?

20And Jesus said unto them, **Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to**

yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

21Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting

Folks, We're on the precipice of destruction as a blessed people that have forgotten their God, so let us return to the God of Our Fathers, apply these tried and true instructions given to us by our Heavenly Father. Tarry with us one hour in fasting and prayer!
